Internship Programme

The internship is open to current and recent postgraduate law school students as well as newly qualified lawyers. We are looking for ambitious and motivated individuals to help us in our work.

Each internship rotation is three months, during which time interns will assist our teams of in-house lawyers with their current projects and missions. Some discretionary funding is available for eligible candidates for internships in the London office.

- Business and Economic Law interns work alongside the IBA Legal Projects Team, in London, supporting the initiatives of the Legal Practice Division and the Section on Public and Professional Interest. Interns will conduct legal research, draft reports and working papers on a variety of commercial topics including corporate governance, anti-corruption, anti-money laundering, multi-jurisdictional practice, competition law and policy, and international trade.
- Human Rights Law interns support the work of the IBA Human Rights Institute (IBAHRI) in London. The IBAHRI's focuses include: the promotion and protection of the independence of the judiciary and the universal adoption, implementation and acceptance of international human rights standards. Recent interns have researched issues such as Islamic law, torture, the death penalty and terrorism; and worked on trial observations, and intervention letters.
- International Criminal Law interns are based in the IBA offices in the Peace Palace in The Hague, supporting the IBA ICC monitoring programme. Interns will conduct research, analyse the evolution of ICC jurisprudence, prepare briefing notes, and attend meetings and sessions of the Court.
