Mr Glenn E. Singleton presenting 'Courageous Conversations about Race'



You are invited to join us for a presentation by Mr Glenn E. Singleton, a leading expert in racial awareness. Co-author of the award winning text *Courageous Conversations About Race: A Field Guide For Achieving Equity In Schools*, the Courageous Conversations program has been specifically adapted for the Australian higher education environment.

Courageous Conversations about Race provides an opportunity for participants to explore race from multiple perspectives, develop language and confidence to engage in complex, challenging and meaningful conversations about race. Myths, stereotyping and prejudice are explored through national and international perspectives and personal narratives about racial identity, power and privilege and their impacts on individuals lived experiences.

Glenn is an engaging presenter and has appeared on ABC's Good Morning America. He is the Founder and President of Pacific Education Group, an organization dedicated to helping

educators to focus on the intersection of race and schooling, and to implement effective strategies for eliminating racial disparities in schools. In 2003, Singleton received the prestigious Eugene T. Carothers Human Relations Award for outstanding service in the fields of human rights and human relations from the National School Public Relations Association. He has hosted and produced educational programs for television and has written numerous articles on the topics of equity, institutional racism, leadership, and staff development, as well as his newly released publication *More Courageous Conversations About Race*. From 2004-2012, he served as an Adjunct Professor of Educational Leadership at San José State University, and is the founder of the Foundation for a College Education (FCE) of East Palo Alto, California.

Monash University will be facilitating the Courageous Conversations about Race program in 2014 and we are delighted to have the opportunity to welcome Mr Glenn E. Singleton to the University.
