What is Nexus 2021?

Nexus 2021 is a free professional development program for artists at any skill or career level. It is designed for and by Deaf and Disabled people, to support and help you jump-start your career in the arts.

Nexus runs for eight weeks and each week focuses on a different topic. You are welcome to come along to all eight sessions, or book into just a few depending on your career interests and needs.

Who can participate?

Nexus 2021 is for Deaf and Disabled artists aged 18-26. Everyone is welcome to apply no matter arts skills or career level.

What are the dates and what is in the program?

Sessions will run on Tuesdays from 3 August – 21 September 2021, 10 am – 1 pm.

The program includes sessions about claiming your space in the Disability Arts sector; networking; self-advocacy; well-being; budgets and finance; promotion; and speaking about yourself and your work.
